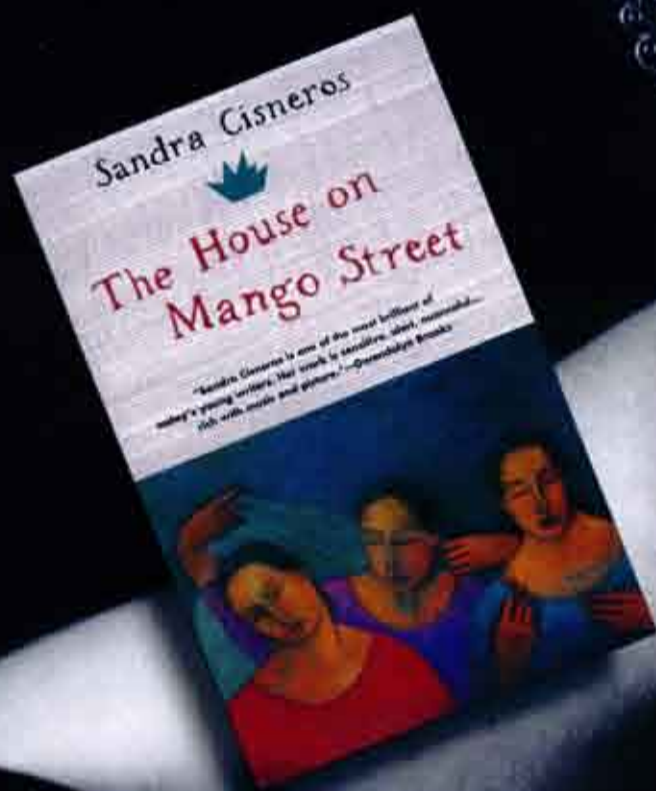


If All Arkansas Read The Same Book
